The protest seeks to close the School of the Americas (SOA). Graduates of the school have been consistently linked to human rights violations and to the suppression of popular movements in the Americas.

Hundreds of thousands of Latin Americans have been tortured, raped, assassinated, "disappeared", massacred, and forced into refuge by those trained at the SOA.
