Friday, Feb 20 - Sophomores
Tuesday, Feb 24 - Freshmen

The last day for initial registration for Spring Trimester is the last business day before the term begins: Thursday, 2 April 2009.

The last day to readmit to the Augsburg for Adult programs for Spring Trimester is the last business day before the term begins: Thursday, 2 April 2009.

Students are encouraged to meet with their faculty advisor and to register early as course availability decreases greatly after the first two weeks of the registration period.
